

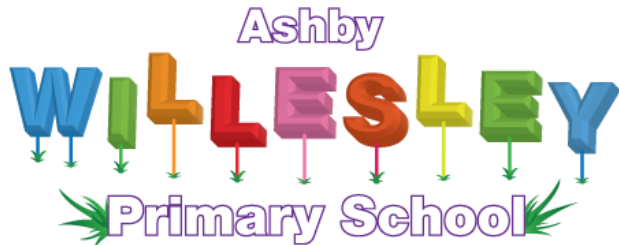

On Thursday 4th October I was privileged to be asked, (for the second year), to speak at the school's Harvest Festival Service held in the magnificent St Helens Church in front of 400 children and about 250 parents.
