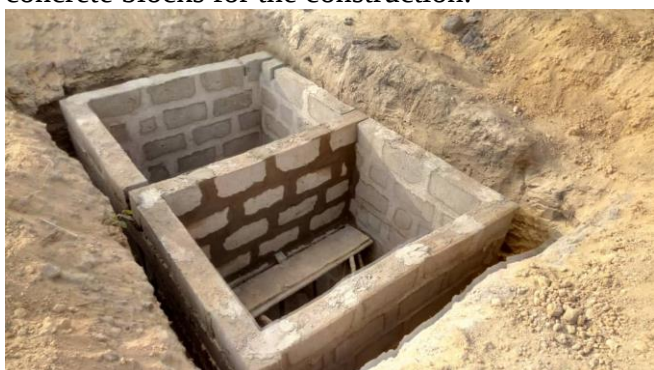


Banbury International Community School
