Not sure about the broken glass on top of the wall !!



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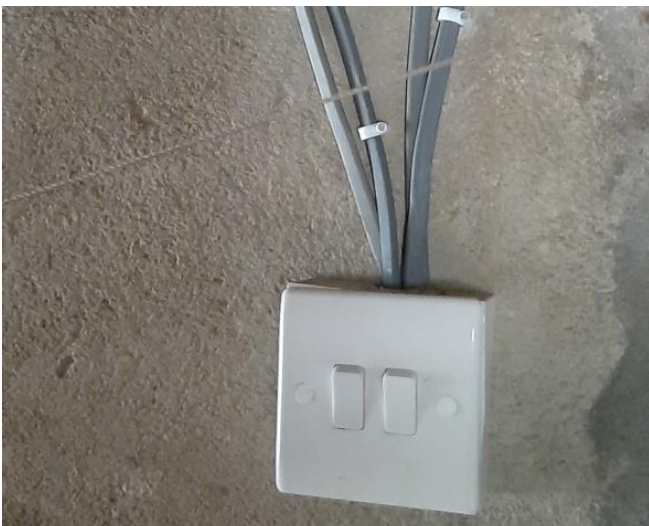


Momoh had an electric Christmas
