The 2 classrooms that are nearing completion are the 40th & 41st funded since January 2007. The 42nd classroom, at Liverpool School, is due to begin early in the New year, as funding permits.

There are several other projects which are helping community members to either gain qualifications or continue their education despite their difficult, challenging personal circumstances.

Sahr, who teaches at Banbury International Community School, has just completed the first year of his Batchelor of Education degree course thanks to the wonderful support of a single donor.
