One of the main reasons for the visit is to oversee the laying out of the staff hostel at Westminster school, which I have now agreed to fund. I have sent enough funds for them to prepare the foundations and produce a first batch of concrete blocks so that they will be ready to start the building when I arrive. We will agree the final layout of the rooms on the first day of my visit to site. Currently five of the staff are spending 15% of their wage on public transport to get them to and from work. Each of the staff will have a single room and I plan to supply each of the rooms with a bed.
